Therefore, it is possible to form social and professional self-awareness in future teachers, to form a positive attitude towards oneself and the environment, to develop cognitive, motivational, regulatory, communicative aspects of a person, and others.

It is also permissible to cite examples of methods that create and develop reflexive activity in training. In particular, such methods as "Sinkway", "Generally unique," and "Amazing debate" are widely used in personal education as methods that create reflection.

"SINKWAY" METHOD

One of the most popular methods used in the development of reflection is —Sinquain. Cinquain is a poem that synthesizes information. The rules for writing such a poem are based on the following example:

- the name of the first line of the poem, the subject (usually a noun);
- the image of the subject of the second line (two adjectives);
- third-line action (usually three verbs belong to the subject);
- the fourth line of emotion (a four-word phrase that expresses the attitude towards the subject);
- the fifth line is a return of the content, words that have the same meaning as the first line (usually a noun).

The main purpose of writing a synopsis is a reflexive assessment of the topic. The syncway method is more commonly used in the final iteration of a theme or section. This method helps to explain complex emotions and topics in a concise manner. Including familiar and unfamiliar, I am reading, thinking, wondering, how wonderful these fairy tales are! A miracle!

"GENERAL INDIVIDUAL" METHOD

This methodology develops the ability to distinguish common and specific features of two or more subjects. According to Bloom's taxonomy, through this method, analytical skills are developed in a person, they operate at the level of synthesis and comparative evaluation.

In this case, individual pair-group methods are used. Here is the methodology graphic methods can be used (Venn diagram). As a result, general characteristics are written on one side, and specific aspects on the other.

"MENTAL ATTACK" METHOD

The purpose of this method is to strengthen knowledge and express new ideas. Mental an attack begins by posing a problem or question. With respect to each opinion it is necessary to relate. It is not possible to use the words "no", "can't be", "wrong".

" TWO-SIDED ROUND TABLE " METHOD

This method is useful in solving actual problems. Participants are divided into two groups. The first group sits in an inner circle and they feel free to express their opinions they get Participants sitting in the outer circle express their attitude to the opinions of those in the first circle. They can add, express their opinion or ask a question. In this process, the teacher should not allow conflict to arise and at the same time should not interfere in the discussion. At the end of the training, conclusions are presented in written and oral form.

At the end, the teacher presents his thoughts and conclusion. This method is the most important and necessary in the development of reflection.

The above-mentioned technologies aimed at organizing reflexive activities help future teachers to acquire self-awareness, control, and management skills in the educational process. In turn, this is important in organizing, managing and organizing the educational process.
